

**CHEMICALS:** REVEAL diluted 1:10

**EQUIPMENT:** Personal Protective Equipment (goggles, gloves)  
Wet Floor Signs  
Dust Mop  
Putty Knife  
Clean Mop Bucket with Wringer  
Clean Rayon Mop with handle  
Wet Pick-up Vacuum (optional)  
Dust Pan & Broom

**PROCEDURES:**

STEPS	KEY POINTS
<p>1. Assemble equipment. 2. Remove any free-standing objects from the floor. Vacuum the walk-off mats and set aside.</p>	<p>1. See above. 2. Place "Caution-Wet Floor" signs at the end of each area. Place walk-off mat at exit area.</p>
<p>3. Dust mop the entire floor. Remove any gum or other material with a putty knife.</p>	<p>3. Deposit in waste receptacle. Work towards the end of the aisle, pick up with dust pan &amp; broom.</p>
<p>4. If the cleaner is not automatically dispensed, mix according to label directions with cool water.</p>	<p>4. Do not use hot water or damage to floor coating may occur.</p>
<p>5. Dip the mophead into the cleaning solution and wring out. Apply in an overlapping figure 8 pattern to ensure even coverage of all floor areas.</p>	<p>5. Return mop to cleaner bucket often to ensure thorough floor cleaning. Change the cleaning solution when it becomes heavily soiled.</p>
<p>6. Clean all equipment. Return to its appropriate area. Remove wet floor signs.</p>	<p>6. Equipment in good clean working order improves the quality of the result.</p>
<p>7. Replace all moved furniture when floor is dry.</p>	<p>7. Return of moved items leaves job complete.</p>
