

PROCEDURES


CHEMICALS: REVEAL diluted 1:10

EQUIPMENT: Personal Protective Equipment (goggles, gloves) Wet Floor Signs Dust Mop Putty Knife Clean Mop Bucket with Wringer Clean Rayon Mop with handle Wet Pick-up Vacuum (optional) Dust Pan & Broom

PROCEDURES:

STEPS


- 1. Assemble equipment.
- 2. Remove any freestanding objects from the floor. Vacuum the walk-off mats and set aside.
- Dust mop the entire floor. Remove any gum or other material with a putty knife.
- 4. If the cleaner is not automatically dispensed, mix according to label directions with cool water.
- 5. Dip the mophead into the cleaning solution and wring out. Apply in an overlapping figure 8 pattern to ensure even coverage of all floor areas.
- Clean all equipment. Return to its appropriate area. Remove wet floor signs.
- Replace all moved furniture when floor is dry.











KEY POINTS

- 1. See above.
- Place "Caution-Wet Floor" signs at the end of each area. Place walk-off mat at exit area.
- Deposit in waste receptacle. Work towards the end of the aisle, pick up with dust pan & broom.
- 4. Do not use hot water or damage to floor coating may occur.
- Return mop to cleaner bucket often to ensure thorough floor cleaning. Change the cleaning solution when it becomes heavily soiled.
- Equipment in good clean working order improves the quality of the result.
- 7. Return of moved items leaves job complete.
