

CHEMICALS: REVEAL diluted 1:10

EQUIPMENT:


Personal Protective Equipment (goggles, gloves)

Wet Floor Signs Dust Mop Putty Knife 2 Clean Mop Buckets with Wringer 2 Clean Cotton Mops with handle Wet Pick-up Vacuum (optional) Dust Pan & Broom

PROCEDURES:

STEPS

- 1. Assemble equipment.
- Remove any freestanding objects from the floor. Vacuum the walk-off mats and set aside.
- 3. Dust mop the entire floor. Remove any gum or other material with a putty knife.
- If the cleaner is not automatically dispensed, mix according to label directions with cool water.
- Dip the mophead into the cleaning solution and lightly wring out. Apply in an overlapping figure 8 pattern to ensure full even coverage of all floor areas.
- 6. Allow the cleaner solution to remain on the floor for 5 minutes then pick up with mop or wet vacuum.











KEY POINTS

- 1. See above.
- 2. Place "Caution-Wet Floor" signs at the end of each area. Place walk-off mat at exit area.
- 3. Deposit in waste receptacle. Work towards the end of the aisle, pick up with dust pan & broom.
- 4. Do not use hot water or damage to floor coating may occur. Wear appropriate safety equipment when handling chemicals.
- Return mop to cleaner bucket often to ensure thorough floor cleaning. Change the cleaning solution when it becomes heavily soiled.
- Do not allow the surface to dry before picking up soiled cleaner solution.





- Use the clean rinse mophead and bucket, apply warm rinse water and pick up with mop or wet vacuum. Allow floor to dry.
- Clean all equipment.
 Return to its
 appropriate area.
 Remove wet floor signs.
- Replace all moved furniture when floor is dry.





- 7. Change rinse water when its becomes heavily soiled.
- 8. Equipment in good clean working order improves the quality of the result.
- 9. Return of moved items leaves job complete.
