

PROCEDURES

FLOORCARE F4 CLEANER AUTOSCRUBBER


CHEMICALS: REVEAL diluted 1:10

EQUIPMENT: Personal Protective Equipment (goggles, gloves) Wet Floor Signs Dust Mop Putty Knife Clean Mop Bucket with Wringer

PROCEDURES:


## STEPS

- 1. Assemble equipment.
- 2. Remove any freestanding objects from the floor. Vacuum the walkoff mats and set aside.
- Dust mop the entire floor. Remove any gum or other material with a putty knife.
- If the cleaner is not automatically dispensed, fill the solution tank of scrubber according to label directions with cool water.
- 5. For light soiling make one pass over the area with pads down, solution valve open and squeegee down.
- 6. For heavy soiling, make one pass over the area with pads down, solution valve open and squeegee up. Make second pass with pads down, solution valve open and squeegee down.

## **KEY POINTS**


- 1. See above.
- Place "Caution-Wet Floor" signs at the end of each area. Place walk-off mat at exit area.
- Deposit in waste receptacle. Work towards the end of the aisle, pick up with dust pan & broom.
- 4. Do not use hot water or damage to floor coating may occur. Wear appropriate safety equipment when handling chemicals.
- Change the cleaning solution when it becomes heavily soiled if using a recycle system.
- Do not allow the surface to dry before picking up soiled cleaner solution. Vacuum can be left off on first pass.



## PROCEDURES

- Use the clean rinse mophead and bucket, trail mop the area just scrubbed paying particular attention to low spots and areas missed by the scrubber.
- Clean all equipment. Return to its appropriate area. Remove wet floor signs.
- 9. Replace all moved furniture when floor is dry.





- 7. Change rinse water when its becomes heavily soiled.
- 8. Equipment in good clean working order improves the quality of the result.
- 9. Return of moved items leaves job complete.
